



ARRIVAL

Here are the necessary steps in arrival and departure. Where they take place is shown on the Terminal Map.

Station 1. TRAFFIC OFFICER checks you off manifest.

2. MEDICAL CLERK checks health and shot records.

3. PASSENGER SERVICE COUNTER, Billet assigned. Be sure to receive a ration card and currency exchange slip.

4. FINANCE OFFICE. All American money should be exchanged for French currency within two hours after arriving. Possession of United States currency is punishable by fine and imprisonment.

5. INCOMING BAGGAGE COUNTER. Boggage will be delivered here. That which you don't want with you at your billet may be checked at Station 6 until departure.

6. BAGGAGE CHECK-IN COUNTER. Claim checks are issued, to be retained until baggage is checked out.

7. TERMINAL RESTAURANT. Hot meals are served at all hours except between 1500 and 1600 local. Through passengers will be admitted on presentation of green plane ticket. Terminating passengers may obtain a pass at Station 3.

8. TRANSPORTATION. Bus to Comp Dushane runs regularly on the hour and half hour. Staff car service is

maintained between hotels and terminal.

9. BAGGAGE CHECK-OUT COUNTER. Reclaim checked baggage.

10. OUTGOING PASSENGER COUNTER. Report here at


designated time.


11. CENSOR'S OFFICE, All United States bound passengers will report for travelers' censorship. Letters, 201 files, diaries, photographs, and films will be inspected. Sufficient time is allowed prior to departure.

12 WEIGH-IN COUNTER. Personal weight and baggage weight will be taken here.




OVER, 1,000 PASSENGERS FLOWN FROM CAZES AIR BASE EACH DAY





In Casablanca, the words RESTAURANT and BAR mean:

DO NOT ENTER!

Transmitted in impure food and water, dysentery diseases are common here. Night-soil is used to fertilize vegetable crops; utensils in restaurants and bars are not clean. Therefore the use of other than army-sponsored mess halls is forbidden. Army sponsored mess halls serve clean food and water. They are the ONLY places here where you may be sure they do.

in Casablanca, the words WANT FUN, JOE? mean:

DEAD END STREET!


Venereal disease is prevalent. Infection of the local populations is high, too high to take a chance on. Hunger and ignorance have driven some of the population to assault and theft. For the most part people are friendly, but play it safe. An offer to introduce you to a woman may lead you to an ambush. Anyone selling rare jewelry on a street corner made it yesterday. A soldier walking alone at night is subject to robbery and attack. These are not just guesses. We KNOW.

In Casablanca, the words BUSINESS, JOE? mean:

DANGER! DYNAMITE!

Commodities - food, clothing, cigarettes - are scarce here. Inflation prevails. Soldiers making sales of ANYTHING are guilty of stimulating the black market and inflation. Sales are forbidden, punishable by imprisonment and severe fine.

In Casablanca, the words: DON'T OVERSTAY YOUR PASS
DON'T BE DRUNK AND DISORDERLY
DON'T DESTROY CIVIL PROPERTY
DON'T GO OFF LIMITS
mean WHAT THEY SAY!

- A VOTRE SERVICE: The French Liason Office is located at Station 16, Terminal building.
- DEAR MOM: All personal mail and parcel post is subject to censorship by base censor. DO NOT disclose dates of departure, routes, nor types of aircraft.



The TIME ON YOUR HANDS: GMT plus 1 hour.


YOU CAN TAKE IT WITH YOU: Baggage allowance for Statesbound passengers is up to 65 pounds per person unless orders specifically authorize overage.
